Justin Lane, sensational wine maker, now moving to the peak of his career. Justin works out of his winery in the McLaren Vale.



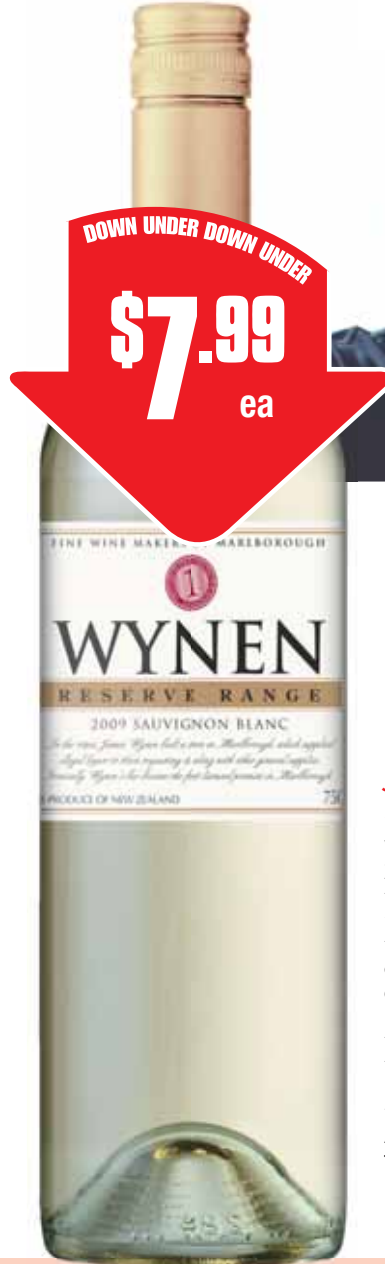
## All South Australian

### Diviner Cabernet Merlot

We purchased this lovely red from a tiny outfit in the Barossa Valley who travel South Australia buying god parcels of wine cheaply. These are shipped back to the Barossa Valley where like alchemists of old the shake and blend to make something special for a very keen price. They tell us they 'divine' up almost from dry ground the very best wines and try to make two plus two something more than four. Anyway that is what they told us and it seems to make some sense. Exactly where the parcels of wine come from they keep to themselves. We do not mind as the wine tastes good to us.

## The Result of 27 Years of Experience

### Yarra Burn Premium Cuvée Brut NV

Alas one of the unfortunate truths about wine is that a delicate, fragrant, light sparkling wine by definition will cost you more than \$10.00 and in general much more. Good sparkling wines require grapes grown in cool climates as this is the only way known to achieve delicacy. Gentle fragrance and a light taste mean it must be made from pinot noir and chardonnay and the vines must fruit at low cropping levels. This pushes up the price a little further. Then considerable skills and mostly expensive wine making processes are needed to preserve all of this in the winery. A long history of making the style also helps and Yarra Burn made the first sparkling wine in the Yarra Valley in 1983. The result is terrific for a quite modest price.

### Fifth Leg Western Australia Shiraz Cabernet Merlot 07/08

Fifth Leg is a delicious blend from one of our favourite regions Western Australia. More specifically we like wines that come from the vineyards that hug the coast from Margaret River and continue east for hundreds of kilometers; though not in a continuous strip we hasten to add. Reds from this region have a unique freshness and fragrance produced by the cooling influence of the great Southern Ocean. Some of the vineyards are quite close to the ocean while others may be by a tens of kilometers inland. It is by blending wines from a number of vineyards that are affected in different ways by the major weather patterns that winemakers can assemble the perfect wine. Fifth Leg is of course made in the 'drink now' manner that we all want and to us it sparkles with the fresh, fruitiness of the newly picked grapes. We like our wines this way.

Nic is less interested in the origin of the grapes than he is of the fruit quality being able to deliver the 'juiciness' that he seeks to bring out in his wines. Sensational wine and we love the finger puppet idea.

## Strawberry Fields Forever

### Killawarra Dusk Sparkling NV

This is one of the new wave fruity, sweeter styles of sparkling wines unashamedly made to appeal to the female drinker. To a good sparkling base the winemakers have added a strawberry flavour, hence the pinkish tint. At Down Under we cannot for the life of us understand why styles like this had to be reinvented. The demand was always there but the wine companies would not make them. This style stretches all the way back to Barossa Pearl which made its debut in 1956 and was followed by a plethora of sparkling wines all of which sold well. Then suddenly nothing-the whole industry seemed to just stop making them. All the Rinegolds, Pearls, Spumantes, Ducks, coloured fizzes of all descriptions just disappeared as if banned. Well they are back so please enjoy.

### Yalumba The Menzies Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon 2006

Coonawarra, deep rich red soils and cabernet sauvignon; they belong together and what a combination they are. The failed experiment by John Riddoch of the 1890's was followed by almost 50 years of nothing apart from one winery struggling on which was Redman. Some very good wines were made in the 1940's and then slowly we drinkers made the move to drinking red wines from the 1950's and Coonawarra was given another chance. In our view the wines are better than they have ever been but with so many other regions to choose from sales are much slower than they were. Which means the contrarian in us sees them as cheaper than they would otherwise be. Great wine at a great price by a company you can trust.

### Taylors Clare Valley Shiraz

One of our Clare favourites is this richly flavoured, deeply coloured Taylors. While the Clare Valley, like most of the vineyard regions of South Australia was opened up in the mid Nineteenth Century, it fell into a long slumber. A small revival began when Australians embraced red wines in the 1960's just when all seemed lost. Taylors began its Clare adventure in 1969 at the Southern end of the Clare Valley near the town of Auburn. Just to show you how long it takes to get a business going it's only in the last decade that they have moved into top gear. Part of the reason is the top winemaking talent they have attracted. It shows in wines such as this which are deeply coloured, rich and vibrant and in our view very fair value.

The southern tip of W.A. does get cold. The wind whips in of the vast southern ocean and it blows and blows. The compensation is that it is excellent vine country and what a pleasure the development of all the WA wine styles has brought to wine drinkers since the early 1970's. We tend to forget how recent all of this is. If this fruit is allowed to ripen; moved to the winery at the right moment, and made into wine in a simple, unfussy way; then wine such as this Madfish result. The wine is mostly chardonnay with the addition of sauvignon blanc, and as the company says; "wines that are without pretension or fuss and are approachable in their youth with flavours and freshness that make them an integral part of a healthy, happy lifestyle involving food, friends and family." We have tasted many vintages of Wither Hills over the last decade and without exception have enjoyed them all. Almost every vintage picks up gold medals going back as far as 1994. That's a pretty good track record. The current chief winemaker Ben Glover continues to build on the skills of Brent Marris who we believe made Wither Hills famous. Ben describes the current vintage this way: "The 2008 Wither Hills Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc shows benchmark characteristics; intense gooseberry, tomato leaf and capsicum characters underpinned by the classically pungent melon, guava and passionfruit aromatics. The palate is extraordinarily balanced with bright seamless acidity, concentration of brambly, mineral lemongrass flavours and a long supple finish. A wine of remarkable intensity." We will let the company have the last say; "Wild Oats Sauvignon Blanc is bright and zesty with crisp fruit and herbal flavours on a lighter palate." Knappstein told us that he makes it clean, fresh and unadulterated just as he does with his sensational sauvignons.

### Montana Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc

Tastes pretty good to us so wins a place in our Best Value Whites Und'r \$11.00, but it does so for another, historical reason. Montana planted the first sauvignon blanc vines in Marlborough way back in 1973 and released the first wine we recall in 1978. It's the wine "whot did it" as now an enormous percentage of what Australians drink each week is this wonder from New Zealand. Back in the late 1970's they exported the first lot to Australia and it was about 350 cases which is what Down Under will sell this week alone. We were retailing wine back then and recall that selling New Zealand wine was seen as a very odd thing to do. Our embrace of these flavours coincides with the year of the Olympics, 2000. It is now causing all sorts of problems as our growers cannot sell varieties which we are good at growing, such as chardonnay. Where this all leads for the local growers we have no idea.

Next a heavy Barossa shiraz was added and the job was done. As a day to day quaffer, this wine will give you great drinking satisfaction. 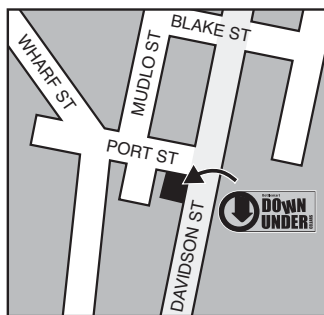

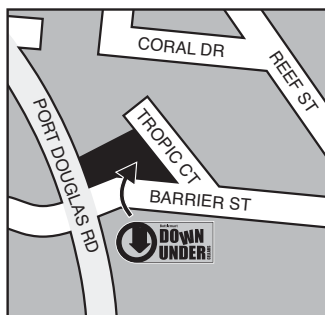

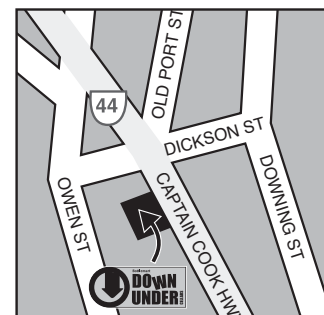
